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## Job Description

You will work with a test group - a class of 20 level 1 pupils (5-6, or 6-7 or 7-8 or 8-9 years old) and their respective class teacher for the entire first term running from September to December 2016. During this period, your task will be to analyze the content and methods of teaching, identify critical errors and together with the teacher, develop new methods of managing the class and teaching key subjects. Your key role will be to develop ideas of how locally available technology can be used in class for teaching and learning. The process will involve:

- Reviewing teaching methods and curriculum.
- Developing hands on possibilities for integrating the use of modern available technology in class.
- Developing hands on possibilities for improving class management and teacher pupil relationship.
- Carrying out short experiments with the test group and comparing outcomes with the control group.

## Opportunities

Volunteerism, Cameroonian culture and socio –political challenges, facilitating/training skills, organization and planning skills, educational challenges in Africa, teaching skills, classroom management, counseling skill, presentation skills, communication skills, improvement of self awareness, develop cultural tolerance and the understanding of others; learn the challenges of implementing new ideas in a different cultural setting and motivating others to participate and contribute in implementing them.
